ABOUT THE COLLEGE

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

When there was a move from 1-year B.Ed. programme to 2-year B.Ed. programme there has been reluctance in accepting the same by the students, teachers and management in implementing the same. There has been reduction in student's enrolment in many places. Now the teacher education programme will be in multidisciplinary HEIs and be 4 years duration. All educational institutions have to implement the NEP 2020 during the coming years which definitely poses challenges especially to the stand alone TEIs.

Therefore, it offers various challenges to be met in implantation like developing content, pedagogy, finance, etc. This seminar is an attempt towards discussing many issues and challenges faced by teacher education institutions especially the introduction of ITEP.
