**About Sainath Education Trust:** The Sainath Education Trust was established in the year 1985 with the sole objective of spreading education in the township of Navi Mumbai beginning from Kindergarten to Post Graduate teaching. The architect of this idea Hon. Shri. Haribansh R. Singh (Member of Parliament), a visionary dreamed to provide higher education to the socially and economically under privileged strata of society at an affordable cost. The Trust started its academic activities by establishing a school in the year 1988, predominantly in Hindi medium which subsequently lead to the establishment of English Medium School. In the same year 1988, the trust established a Junior college in the streams of Arts, Science and Commerce and a Degree College in the year 2002. Moving one step ahead to cater the needs of Higher Education and to contribute in the development of a healthy and intellectual society the Trust established Teachers Training College (B.Ed. and D.T. Ed.) in 2006. Shri. Haribansh Singh, Member of Parliament, Lok Sabha, Chairman feels it is humble pie to make Vibrant India. More than 5,000 students are engaged in learning in the institutes created by the Trust mostly drawn from under privileged strata of the society.

The H B B. Ed College is Affiliated to University of Mumbai and recognised by National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE). As per the guidelines of University of Mumbai, the College has introduced a Women's Development Cell (WDC) in the academic year 2011-12. It looks into the grievances/complaints of teaching, non-teaching staff and students, especially in cases of gender discrimination. WDC is committed to organise such various programs, seminars and workshop to create legal awareness on women issues and to prepare our students to face the challenges of 21<sup>st</sup> century. The future classroom teachers need to be equipped to meet the emerging challenges, therefore teachers need to be oriented. In that direction we have started the tradition of organising seminar series annually. We started with a State level seminar on **“Counselling- A Silent Necessity”** in 2011. In 2012 we have organised National level seminar on **“Empowerment of Teachers—a practical solution”** and published all the papers in a book form. **During 2013** we organised **MOEF (Ministry of Environment and Forests, New Delhi)** sponsored two days National Seminar in collaboration with Thane Belapur Industrial Association and Rajiv Gandhi College of Arts Science and Commerce, Vashi on **“Creating Awareness to Conserve and Protect Environment-Role of Education”**. The proceedings have been published in two volumes with ISBN. In 2014 we organized one day workshop to help the teachers and the educational institutions to prepare for the **“NAAC Accreditation Process”**. In 2015 we organized an International Symposium on **“Role of Politics in Education”** to celebrate our Chairman's victory as a Member of Parliament and to have a broad discussion on Politics and Education.

In 2016 we organised two days National Workshop on “**Developing Awareness on Yoga-A Way of Life**”. In academic year of 2017 is remarkable as our Institution has successfully completed ten years in the academic excellence and service to the society. In **April, 2017** we organized two days National level seminar on “**Contribution of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar and Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj to Society**”. In 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2018 we organized one day seminar on “**Contribution of Swami Vivekananda and Sister Nivedita on Education**” by observing the 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Sister Nivedita, This year we have planned to organize one day national seminar on the subject of “**Integrated Teacher Education Programme: Facts, Fears and Futures**” to give opportunity to a large number of teachers to participate in the form of presenting papers.

**Concept Note about the Seminar:** The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), a statutory body under HRD ministry has launched a new academic program commencing from next academic session. The Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) has been launched for class 12<sup>th</sup> pass students by NCTE to enhance the teaching profession in the country. Integrated Programme is perhaps the need of the hour be it teacher education, management, law, basic science etc. We have seen five year integrated law programmes (B.A. LL.B) so also management programmes (BA/B.Com and MBA) and integrated Science programmes (B. Sc. and M.Sc.) We hear that four year B.Ed. programme and two year B.Ed. programme will continue parallelly. However it is also heard that gradually the two year programme will make way for four year programme. This has no doubt created lot of confusion in the minds of the stakeholders: parents, students, teachers and principals. Are those hearings are gossips only or a reality, even any facts, fears and future for ITEP? Let us discuss it in threadbare in one day national seminar. Therefore it is proposed to hold this national seminar for wider discussions and deliberations on “**Integrated Teacher Education Programme: Facts, Fears and Futures**”.

### **Objectives of the Seminar**

- To discuss what we gain and what we loose from the one/two/three/four year Teacher Education Programme introduced in our country.
- To know about the details of curriculum transaction in four year integrated teacher education programme namely B.A. and B.Ed. and B.Sc. and B.Ed. and three year B.Ed. and M.Ed. Programme.

- Can a standalone Teacher Education Institute run ITEP? Who will teach the core courses, about their appointments etc.
- What is there in the ITEP for the people in the management of the TEI's, Principals, Teacher Educators and students? How do they cope with prolonged years of stay of students in the campus?
- To ascertain the views of stakeholders towards four-year integrated teacher education programme.

**The Seminar will focus on the following Sub-themes**

- Overview of academic programme: Four-year and three year integrated teacher education programme. (Scope, course-duration, fees, eligibility criteria, syllabus, admission process, career prospects)
- The extant Teacher Education Programme at RIEs under NCERT
- Current status of four-year integrated teacher education programme in India.
- Challenges and Issues in Implementation of integrated teacher education programme (ITEP).
- Pros and Cons of integrated teacher education programme (ITEP).

**Target Audience:** The target group is teachers at all levels, PTA members, parents, college students, local leaders, administrators, teacher educators, researchers, curriculum designers & policy makers etc.

**Outcome of the Seminar:** Education is the best media to propagate such valuable information to the general public. Being a Professional institution we have the good opportunity to create the people who create the generations. The generations which are going to be the future citizens of India. "Good teachers make good students" So, the change in the teacher training courses has come about some discrepancies in the teacher education system. The Minister of Human Resource Development, Shri Prakash Javadekar mentioned cases of misunderstanding, communication gaps and laxity in the way the education was being provided. However the integrated B. Ed programme will definitely provide a new direction to the teaching field. There may be many who may be against this decision due to some reasons but one should remember that knowledge is never ending, more knowledge you gain and more you are prepared for our life. Ultimately it is going to benefit the youth of our country. May be this decision of government will definitely bring a revolution in the education

system, hence will ensure that the future teachers will definitely prove to be a boon for the educational system. This seminar will give opportunity to the participants to pen down their views in the form of presentation.
