5th September, 2025.

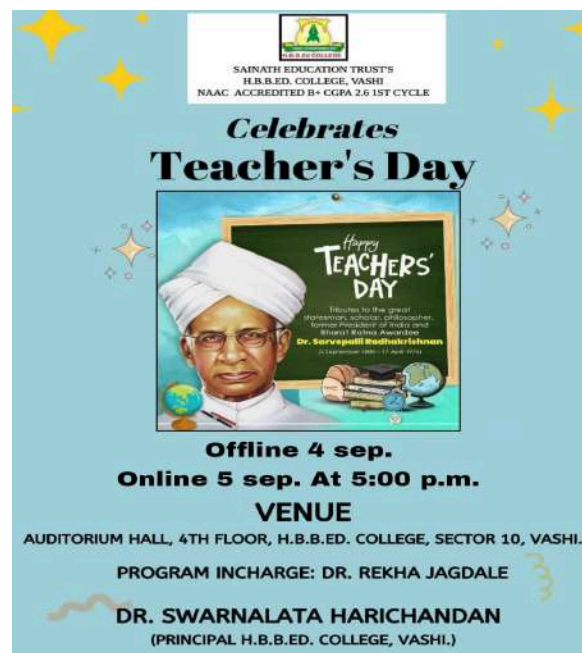

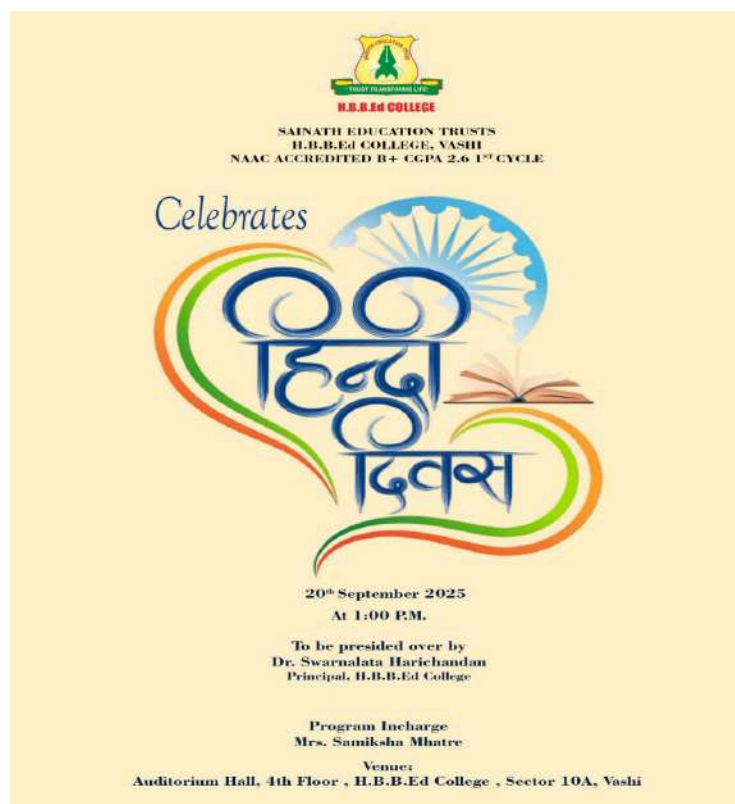

The Agastya Volunteering Programme (AVP) Orientation and Workshop on Teaching Aid Making was organized by H.B. B.Ed College, Vashi, in collaboration with Agastya International Foundation. Dr. Sati Shinde introduced the esteemed guest speaker, Mr. Pradip Kasurde, who provided an insightful introduction to the Agastya Volunteering Programme (AVP) and delivered an engaging orientation session.

Mr. Kasurde conducted orientation of AVP programme. He explained importance of teaching and how teaching aids play a crucial role in enhancing the teaching-learning process. He also explained how teaching aid make abstract concepts concrete, simplify complex ideas, and help retain students' attention. By involving visual, auditory, and kinesthetic elements, teaching aids cater to diverse learning styles. They also make lessons more interactive, engaging, and memorable, thus improving students' understanding and long-term retention of knowledge.

Mr. Kasurde demonstrated various teaching aids across multiple subjects and encouraged students to actively participate in hands-on activities. Some activities included:

-Creating teaching aids to understand different types of sound using straws.

-Producing music using rubber bands and ice cream sticks.

-Assembling a complete human skeleton using paper cut-outs.

-Demonstrating persistence of vision using paper cut-outs and ice cream sticks.

Students enthusiastically participated in making these aids, gaining valuable practical skills. The workshop offered innovative methods to simplify complex concepts and make learning more effective.

At the end of the session, students shared feedback and completed registrations for the AVP programme. The event concluded with a Vote of Thanks by Vijaya, a second-year B.Ed student.

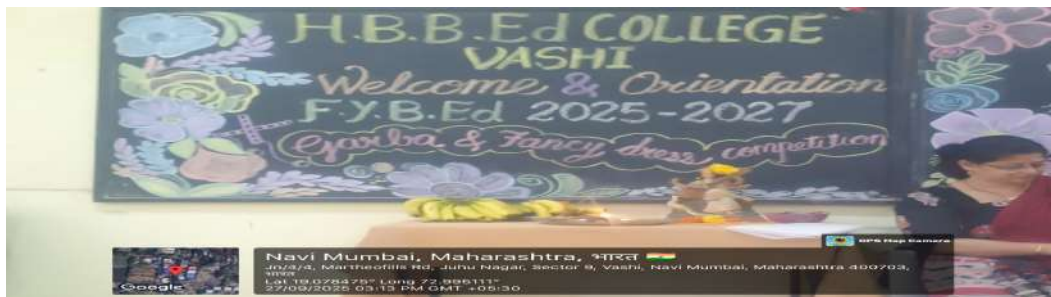
